

## **Explain what these terms mean:**

Precipitation: Precipitation is water released from clouds in the form

of rain, freezing rain, sleet, snow, or hail.

Transpiration: Transpiration occurs when plants take up liquid water

from the soil and release water vapor into the air from their leaves.

Evaporation: Evaporation is the process that changes liquid water to

gaseous water (water vapor).

Condensation: Condensation is the process where water vapor becomes liquid.

It is the reverse of evaporation, where liquid water becomes a vapor.

Accumulation: Accumulation is the process of water collecting in rivers,

lakes, streams, oceans and other bodies of water.
